HOW TO GAIN A MOTORSPORT LICENCE

- 1. Join a club.
- 2. Decide what level of licence you need and follow the steps listed:

M Grade Licence

This licence allows you to do all the clubsport events including motorkhana, autocross, sprints (including at tracks such as Taupo), hillclimbs, rallysprints and drifting events.

There is a short test for an M grade motorsport licence so you need to study the Drivers Guide, which you will find at:

Then you need to take the test - so ring the number below and set it up.

R Grade Licence

Initially issued as an R1 Grade this allows you to compete in all clubsport events and National Rallies (except those rallies where MNZ deem it a requirement for an R2 licence).

- R1 Grade obtained by gaining a pass in the R Grade licence examination. You should study as noted below:
 - 1. National Sporting Code
 - 2. Schedule P Penalties
 - 3. Appendix Two Schedule A Driver and Vehicle Safety

C Grade Licence

Initially issued as a C1 Grade this allows you to complete in all clubsport events and National Race events (except those where MNZ deem it a requirement for a C2 licence).

- C1 Grade obtained by gaining a pass in the C Grade licence examination. You should study as noted below:
 - 1. National Sporting Code
 - 2. Schedule P Penalties
 - 3. Appendix Two Schedule A Driver and Vehicle Safety
