

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS OLD COACH ROAD TARMAC SPRINT SUNDAY 19 FEBRUARY 2023

1. JURISDICTION

This event is a ClubSport Advanced Event, promoted by Motorsport Bay of Plenty at Old Coach Road, Pukehina, Tauranga.

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

3. EVENT DESCRIPTION:

3.1

The event will be a Tarmac 3.34km Bent Sprint. There will be Recce and three (3) timed runs. The number of runs may be varied at the CoC's discretion, and the event may be cancelled for reasons of force majeure or safety.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE: Reconnaissance or practice on the course at any time is strictly forbidden. Any report of a breach of this requirement will be strictly dealt with in accordance with the MSNZ National Sporting Code – Sch P – Penalties, NSC.4.

Venue: Old Coach Road, commencing at the Pukehina School. Parking and Pits in school grounds.

3.4 Results: Fastest run wins, by class and overall. NOTE: The timing equipment used records both reaction time and jumped starts. In the case of a jumped start a penalty of 5 seconds will be applied to that run.

3.2 Classes: Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

A	0-1600cc
B	1601-2000
C	2001-3500cc
D	3501 and over
E1	4WD pre year 2000
E2	4WD year 2000 and over
XC	Cross Cars

4. ENTRIES:

4.1 Entries should be made through the MotorSport Online system (<https://possum.motorsport.org.nz>). Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received.

Late entries will be accepted up until 9am on the day. Late entries will be accepted only at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

4.2 Opening and Closing Dates:

Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close (at normal fees) on Friday 16 February at 5:00pm.

Entries received after the normal fee-closing date are subject to late fee.

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING:

5.1 Licence Requirements:

All drivers must hold as a minimum an M Grade Competition Licence and current membership with a member club.

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

5.2 Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors' obligations, and
- Appendix Five, Schedule C.

5.3 All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.

6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

- 6.1 Compliance:** All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Five Schedule C and Appendix Two Schedule A of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

7. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

- 7.1 Documentation:** 08:00 to 09:15 at the Event Trailer.
- 7.2 Scrutineering Audit Inspection:** 08:00 to 09:15. Competitors will be advised at documentation if their vehicle has been selected for audit.
- 7.3 Accident Damage:** Competitors are reminded that, in accordance with Schedule A Part 1, Article 3.4 (8), if there is significant damage sustained, it is the Competitor's responsibility to present the vehicle and Logbook to the Event Chief Scrutineer for inspection and notation of any applicable information.
- 7.4 Drivers' Briefing:** 09:30. This will be held at the venue by the Event Trailer. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory – a roll call will be taken and failure to attend will result in a penalty.
- 7.5 Recce and Subsequent Timed Runs:** 10:00

8. OFFICIAL BULLETINS

- 8.1** Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

9. GENERAL INFORMATION

- 9.1 Passengers:** May only be carried in accordance with Appendix Five, Schedule C Article 6.2.
- 9.2** Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.
